Tomb of the Unknown Soldier A Century of Honor, 1921 – 2021 Presented by Phillip Bigler

Quicksburg resident Philip Bigler will present the program based on the history of one of the most unique monuments in the United States - the **Tomb of the Unknown Soldier**. His book, Tomb of the Unknown Soldier: A century of Honor, 1921-2021 tells the story of the shrine that was put up to honor the country's fallen soldiers.

Bigler, who worked as a historian at Arlington National Cemetery in the 1980's, said he spent two years doing research on the monument, which was set up at the cemetery after the end of the first World War.
